1. PARTICIPANTS

1. They must be citizens of the represented country (must provide proof of citizenship at the tournament venue registration, e.g. a personal passport issued by the represented country)
2. Age in agreement with their competition category
3. They must know, fully understand and be able to compete in accordance with the ITKF competition rules
4. They must be free of any physical or mental handicap that might cause a breach of the ITKF rules
5. All KUMITE, KO-GO and FUKU-GO athletes are obliged to wear the official ETKF KUMITE GLOVES. For hygienic reasons gloves cannot be shared between athletes. Mouth (tooth) guards are also mandatory to be worn.
6. Breast-protection for women, groin protector for men are optional, but recommended safety equipment
7. They must have his/her own international traveling insurance and also personal accident insurance issued by their respective National Federations
8. Only individuals holding a valid ETKF Certified Coaches Qualification and properly registered with the Tournament Controlling Body will be allowed to represent and coach athletes during the competition
9. They must present Medical Release and International Health Insurance to Medical Emergencies
10. All countries must bring their national anthem (on a CD) and two national flags

IF HE PARTICIPATES IN TEAM CATEGORY FOR AN OLDER AGE GROUP, HE CANNOT PARTICIPATE IN THE SAME TEAM CATEGORY IN HIS AGE GROUP . *Example: one junior athlete can participate in individual categories for juniors. He can participate in team kata for youth. In this case he cannot be part of team kata juniors .*

7. JUDGES

1. **Selection of the Judges will be made by the ETKF Technical Committee Members during the ETKF Judges Course held right before the Tournament.**
2. Judges participating in this event must be ETKF Registered Qualified Judges (class A, B, C) who have participated in and completed the Judges Course held before the Tournament.
3. Each judge candidate must submit the application form, fee and passport size photograph for the Judges Course and Judges Examination by May 1st, 2019, or at the spot. Only Judges whom renewed their license (2018+) and paid the license fee are eligible to attend and be selected to judge at the ETKF European Championship.
4. All Judges must bring their own HAKAMA (black), whistle and KARATEGI
